Thinking about joining a Fury8 way team in 2010? Curious to know more about the Fury8 project? This booklet will provide you with all the information you need to decide if an 8-way project fits your goals.

What is Fury8? It is a project where each member of Perris Fury organizes an 8-way team in 2010 to compete in Nationals. Each team will have their own set of unique goals and purposes ranging from learning, fun, and competition.

In 2010 we are keeping the format from 2009, with a tunnel camp at Paraclete XP in North Carolina. This will give all of the teams a jump start on their season.

A Better Option

- No searching smaller dropzones for three (or seven!) RW enthusiasts
- Train in Perris, CA! Famous sunny weather, tunnel in the parking lot, three Super otters and a skyvan, huge gear store, bar and restaurant, pool, and bunkhouse.
- Improve your skills more than you ever imagined
- Only four weekends taking you away from work, family, weddings, and summer block parties

Package Details

Selection

Teams are not being selected like your grade-school soccer team; you will not be the last kid off the bench hoping you aren't picked last. When forming the teams, we are searching for the most compatible group. This doesn't equate to the most talented, experienced or well known.

With your application, videos, references, and Dan BC's help, we pick those with the most well-matched goals, abilities, interests, and personalities. Basically, if you are a super serious competitive sort, it is unlikely we would group you with the team whose primary goal is socializing and fun.

Application Process

To see if there is a team that matches your needs, just fill out the application and mail, fax, email, or send a singing telegram to Fury. We will then send you a sample team contract with lots of boring, but important, fine print. Fury will gather all the applications (**deadline January 31!**) and create the most logical groups of teams. If you are accepted into a group, the final schedule and price will be confirmed. If you are excited by the opportunity presented, sign the contract and send a deposit.

Budgeting

Each package includes your skydives, video, and guidance by Dan BC and the Fury team. The groups are fully organized – so you don't have to worry about finding other teammates, a camera person, packers, alternates, fill-ins, or coaches. There is no stress in figuring the budget, communicating to eight people, figuring out jumps, making a best-of video, or a camp plan.

Team members get to participate in all the 'fun' parts of being a team – showing up to the DZ, making great jumps, learning and laughing with fun people, picking a team name, and hanging out after jumping.

Below are the three possible team structures. The formed teams will choose the package that meets their members' needs the best. (Don't worry, you will find out your team type before you commit!)

Team A

72 skydives with video
8 shared hours of tunnel (Perris)
4 shared hours of tunnel (Paraclete)
20/40 minute calls

Total cost: \$5300

*** prices are based on current fuel prices. Number of jumps will be adjusted up or down if retail jump rates increase or decrease by more than a \$1

Team B

96 skydives with video
4 hours shared tunnel (Paraclete)
20 minute calls

Team C

120 skydives with video
4 hours shared tunnel (Paraclete)
Back to back 20's

Total cost: \$6100

Calendar

The schedule will be set for the season for all four teams before you commit. No changes will be made, making it easy to plan your life around. Your team will be training either the first set of dates or the second set of dates listed below. Confirmed training dates will be provided as early as possible.

If you can not make the dates listed, still send an application and note what days are giving you difficulty. We may be able to accommodate your particular conflict.

Each team will determine the type of pace that is appropriate. For the most experienced groups, back to backs are a possibility. For the less experienced groups 20 and 40 minute calls are the most likely option.

Pre-camp organizing with Fury available to those coming in early.
Optional evening dinner.

Thursday

Meet at 7:00am for stretch, brief, and prep
8:00-4:00pm: Jumping. Pace is determined by the team plan.
4:00pm: Block Talk with Dan BC
6:00pm: Evening entertainment included in package. This activity is something like mini-golf, bowling, or a movie.

Friday

Meet at 7:00am for stretch, brief, and prep
8:00-4:00pm: Jumping. Pace is determined by the team plan.
4:00pm: Block Talk with Dan BC

6:00-8:00pm: Optional tunnel time can be scheduled

Saturday

Meet at 7:00am for stretch, brief, and prep
8:00-4:00pm: Jumping. Pace is determined by the team plan.
6:00pm: Evening entertainment included in package. This evening can be a BBQ, game night, murder mystery dinner, or social oriented event.

Sunday

Meet at 7:00am for stretch, brief, and prep
8:00-4:00pm: Jumping. Pace is determined by the team plan.
6:00pm: Close out and green light!
